






As an administrator, you have the ability to view student enrollment, module completion, and pre- and post-course scores within the Canvas gradebook. Here's how...

ACCESS YOUR ACCOUNT

Log in to your Inceptia Canvas account and open your school's link from the Admin or Dashboard options in your navigation pane.






OPEN THE GRADEBOOK

This will take you to your course home page. Select **Grades** to open the Gradebook.



ORGANIZE YOUR VIEW

The Gradebook default view can be changed by using the Gradebook View, or Actions menus. All students will be listed, or you can use Search Students to view a particular student.




Students who have completed a course will have a score in both the **Pre** and **Post** course columns. Please note the **Total** column aggregates any completed quizzes, even if a student has not finished that course.

You can also drag and drop columns in any way that you choose to reconfigure the default view of your Gradebook. For instance, you may choose to move all the **Post** quiz scores to the first column as an easy confirmation that a student has completed that module. To drag and drop, click on the name of the item you want to move and drag it to the new location.

DOWNLOAD RECORDS

The Gradebook can be exported using the **Actions** dropdown menu.




INDIVIDUAL STUDENT PROGRESS

You can also easily view individual student progress from within the **Modules** option, after clicking **View Progress**. This will allow you to see in greater detail what the student has completed/has left to complete.
